Clinical Training

The Pennsylvania/MidAtlantic AETC offers a variety of clinical training programs taught by an expert, multidisciplinary faculty. The training of primary care providers involved in the provision of clinical care to persons living with HIV/AIDS is a particular focus.

The clinical teaching experience includes:

- ❖ Comprehensive HIV primary care including secondary prevention
- ❖ Antiretroviral regimens: balancing considerations of viral load immune reconstitution and future therapy options with treatment adherence, medication complications, and quality-of-life issues
- ❖ Diagnosis and treatment of opportunistic infections
- ❖ Comprehensive care components such as psychiatric, nutrition, case management, and addiction treatment
