Clinical Training:

The Pennsylvania/MidAtlantic AETC offers health professionals in all disciplines a variety of programs at different levels, all taught by an expert, multidisciplinary faculty. A particular focus is the training of primary care providers involved in direct provision of clinical care to persons with HIV/AIDS.

The clinical teaching experience includes:

- ❖ HIV primary care.
- ❖ Antiretroviral regimens: balancing considerations of viral load immune reconstitution and future therapy options with treatment adherence, medication complications, and quality of life issues.
- ❖ Diagnosis and treatment of opportunistic infection.
- ❖ Comprehensive care components such as psychiatric, nutrition, case management, and addiction treatment.

Consultation:

Clinical consultation includes case-based discussion with cases supplied by trainee, or clinical consultation on-site at trainee's clinical setting.
